Delmer Miller reported that some trees needed removing in front of 210 Washington and the north tree at the Fontanelle Drug. Another tree at the Drug Store needs a limb removed. Delmer is to contact David Bathurst for an estimate.

Delmer also reported that the cost of fixing the High Surface Pump would be closer to \$4000, so a new pump was purchased for \$3650. The new pump has a capacity of 98 gal. per minute.

Delmer reported that the electricity will be off some Sunday afternoon for approximately two hours while reclosure and bypass work is being done. An ad will be placed in the Observer informing the public.

The REC purchased five new poles and nine used ones during the ice storm. Delmer is to decide on the price.

One of the old transformers has been properly disposed of and three others are being retrofilled. Some work is going to be done on the rural line and lightning arresters.

Delmer asked to have road graveled from Dodson's to the blacktop, approximately 1/4 mile.

Chief Melvin Smith asked for a PBT breath analyzer for spot checks on youth. The cost would be app. \$200 - \$400. No motion was made. Mel also asked for booklets on criminal law and moter vehicle law.
