Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer Miller reported that the sewer permit may not be approved but he planned to have the system smoked to find out where the extra water was coming from. He also stated that he thought that the poles should be numbered before the sale. He had checked on metering for the tie line to Greenfield Duane Armstead thought that 2400 line would carry it. If not, another sub station would be needed. The Electric outage was a fault by Al Herman's. It had a Tee in the middle of it which fed Glen Franks so an overhead line was put in for a temporary line until the other underground could be repaired.

Delmer reported that there is going to be a water school to be held in Ames on May 23 & 24th and would like to have Garry Miller attend. Motion by Robert Edwards to send Garry Miller to the Water school and to pay his expenses and registration. Seconded by Leland Thompson. Carried.

Delmer reported that he would like to have an Engineer to help with the line to Greenfield if the Council would approve.

Motion by Leland Thompson to have an Engineer assist Delmer if needed. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

Police Chief Melvin Smith gave his monthly report and gave the price of a breath analyser.

Harvey Wallace representing the Adair County Economic Development and Tourism Group met with the Council. He reported that the group is in need of a full time person to present economic development to the legislature. This person would serve all of Adair County and would help present all plans for obtaining grants.

Harvey explained that in order to have a full time director there was a need for fundung. Each City in the County would be expected to donate \$2.00 per capita to fund the program. This would cost the City of Fontanelle approximately \$1600. The Adair County economis development committee has appropriated \$6500. and the Tourism group has appropriated \$3500. An office would have to be established but it could be that a temporary office could be put into some other office. He reported that Greenfield has agreed to go along with the program if a full time man is hired.

Clint Hight, City Attorney related that a partial release had been received for the Dodson property. When the lot is paid for a copy of the check will be sent to the Attorney for his files.

The County Engineer and supervisors had agreed to pay one-half the cost of re-doing the west part of Summerset Street, butthey did recommend that,he corner be graded out for a better drainage situation.

Don Baudler met with the Council regarding the approach to his garage. The Council felt that a tube would be best. Delmer is to meet with Mr. Baudler on Wednesday morning to decide which is the best way.
