Whereupon the Mayor declared the Resolution duly adopted as: RESOLUTION NO. 91.1

Following the budget hearing, the departmental reports were given. Delmer presented bids he had received for a new pickup and utility box. Motion by Hepler to take Schildberg's bid on the pickup. Seconded by Thompson. Pitts abstained. Carried.

Motion by Edwards to take AMS's bid on a fiberglass box. Seconded by Hepler. Carried.

The color was left up to Delmer, Dale and Garry.

Tim Ostroski of SICOG informed the council what month they would need to start on the program schedule for the sewer project. Also, he would be sending out procurement bids to engineering firms. At the April meeting the engineering firm would need to be decided.

Chief Smith presented only his monthly report.

Lois presented a bid from All American Beauty Turf for fertilization and aeration of the park. The council instructed Lois to obtain a bid from Grandpa's Greenhouse before a decision will be made.

Motion by Pitts to let Lois attend the spring meeting of the IMFOA in Des Moines on April 18 & 19. Seconded by Ehrenfried. Carried.

Motion by Hepler to send for a four in one poster on employment laws that must be displayed at the office. Seconded by Theompson. Carried.

Motion by Hepler to raise the rental rate of the Community Center by \$5, bringing the cost to \$20, and to not allow garage sales to be held in the building. Seconded by Edwards. Carried.

The questionnaire sent to the town by Iowa Codification, Inc. was tabled until Wednesday, March 6, when the council will meet and discuss the questions in length.
