Voted Nay: Ehrenfried. Carried.

Mark Fensel with H. R. Green was unable to attend this meeting, so asked Delmer to give the council an update on the sewer project.

There were eight applicants for the position of cleaning person. After viewing the applications, a motion was made by Ehrenfried to hire Debbie Frank at \$4.65 for a three month probationary period. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

Motion by Hepler to waive the second reading of proposed Ordinance 131 and moved for its adoption. Seconded by Ehrenfried. Carried. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Hepler, Edwards, Ehrenfried, Pitts and Thompson. NAY: None. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the motion duly carried and the Ordinance adopted as:

ORDINANCE 131

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF FONTANELLE, IOWA, 1991, BY AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 3-3.0302 PERTAINING TO THE SEWER RENTAL RATE.

The contracts for ½ & ½ roads was examined. Motion by Hepler to have the Mayor sign said contracts. Seconded by Edwards. Carried.

Motion by Pitts to give the employees a \$75 Christmas bonus. Seconded by Edwards. Carried.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer reported his progress in checking costs for a generator to be used to run the community center, fire station, fire whistle and city building.

Delmer is to see if the railroad will sell the portion of land adjoining the city lot, and check on the cost.

The Christmas lights are being put up.

An inspector from the Commerce Commission was here to check the rural line.

Lois read a letter from the DNR informing the council that they are in general agreement with the revised plan of action which eliminates the pumping station renovation and force main installation.

Motion by Ehrenfried to adjourn. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.

The Fontanelle Fire & Rescue Management Committee met at 7:00 pm at City Hall with Mayor Means calling the meeting to order. Committee members present were: Edwards, Ehrenfried, Hepler, Jacobson, Frank and Nelson. Absent: None.

Motion by Edwards to approve the agenda. Seconded by Jacobson. Carried.

Motion by Ehrenfried to approve the minutes as read. Seconded by Nelson. Carried.

Motion by Hepler to approve the finance report. Seconded by Jacobson. Carried.

Two bills were presented at this time. One from Hawkeye Fire & Safety for \$152.25, for filling the fire extinguishers that belong to the Fire Dept. The second bill had not been received at the time of the meeting. It will be from Midwest Fire Equipment for work done on the fire engine's tank. Motion by Nelson to approve both bills. Seconded by Edwards. Carried.

Chief Ray Stewart reported that from June 26 through Dec. 18, there had been 19 rescues, 9 fires and 6 meetings. The total owed for fires and meetings comes to \$708. Also, the Fire Dept. elected officers and with board approval will keep the officers the same as last year. Motion by Jacobson to pay the Fire Dept. for fires and meetings and also to approve the officers. Seconded by Ehrenfried. Carried.
