Rita Eble of SICOG discussed a five year development plan with the Council. It was decided to hold a special meeting Feb. 24, 1992, at City Hall at 7:00 p.m., to further discuss this plan and propose any ideas at that time.

A draw down was presented at this time for \$4668.82 to H R Green for CDBG funds. Motion by Thompson to have Mayor Pro Tem Pitts sign this draw down. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried.

A quarterly activity status report was also presented. Motion by Armstrong to have Mayor Pro Tem Pitts sign this report. Seconded Tiedeman. Carried.

Mark Duben of H R Green Co. gave the Council a status report on the sewer project. He also showed the Council the detail plans.

Rep. Dave Hibbard visited with the Council and asked for any ideas or suggestions for the legislative session. Much discussion followed.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer reported that there is a possibility that approximately \$8000 may be reimbursed to the City from Disaster Services for costs incurred during the Oct. 30 ice storm.

Generaters were discussed and it was decided to table any further discussion until a later date.

Delmer had attended a SIMECA meeting and reported that the WAPA wheeling and the energy charge on our electricity purchased from CIPCO would be raised.

Chief Smith gave the council his monthly report. He also said he is still looking for a part-time officer.

Lois showed the Council a letter from the League stating that is is possible the State will cut funds for the Road Use Tax Fund, making less street work probable. She also showed the Council another proposal for the park fertilization.

Under public input, Amanda Carstens of the 4-H Club, presented the Council with ideas for the 4-H Club to make improvements to the slab. She asked to be on the agenda for March's meeting.

Motion by Tiedeman to adjourn. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.
