The budget amendment hearing was set for Monday, May 18, at 7pm at city hall. The mayor instructed the clerk to publish the hearing notice according to laws.

Motion by Armstrong to adopt a resolution authorizing the continued participation in Workers' Comp coverage with Iowa Municipalities Workers' Compensation Association. Seconded by Thompson. Carried. The mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as:

AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE AGREEMENT AND MEMORANDUM WITH IOWA MUNICIPALITIES WORKERS' COMPENSATION ASSOCIATION

An evaluation of Debbie Frank's work was done. Motion by Tiedeman to raise her wages to \$5.25. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried.

Motion by Armstrong to hire two people at \$5.50 per hour for general labor with the city. These would be temporary jobs for the summer, and would include filling cracks in the street, painting, mowing with a tractor, and general labor. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

A new building on the town lot was discussed. Motion by Hepler to go ahead with this building. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

The council instructed the clerk to put a piece in the paper about town cleanup. Also to put a piece in about dogs running loose.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer reported that a transformer needed to be reset at the bank and an elbow worked on. Also, some wires at the Co-op needed work.

Delmer also informed the council that meter testing would have to be done. Probably all single phase and maybe three phase.

The police reports were presented.

Motion by Armstrong to adjourn. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried.

The Fontanelle City Council met in special session at City Hall at 7 pm with Mayor Ehrenfried calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Thompson, Pitts, Armstrong and Hepler. Absent: Tiedeman.

Motion by Thompson to approve the agenda. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried.

The Mayor convened the Public Hearing proposing the budget amendment, at which time it was considered and taxpayers could voice their opinions for or against the amendment. The council, after hearing all taxpayers wishing to be heard and considering the statements made by them, gave final consideration to the proposed amendment to the budget. Thereupon, the following resolution was introduced:

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1992 (AS AMENDED LAST ON MARCH 4, 1992)

Motion by Hepler to approve the amendment to the budget and moved for the adoption of corresponding resolution. Seconded by Thompson. Carried. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Thompson, Pitts, Armstrong and Hepler. NAY: None. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as:

RESOLUTION 92.10

The Public Hearing was then closed.

Motion by Thompson to have the Clerk put a Public Hearing Notice in the paper having a bid letting for the purchase and erection of a pole building on the town lot on June 1, 1992, at 8 pm at City Hall. Seconded by Pitts. Carried. The Clerk was also instructed to advertise for bids with the specs and information being available at the City Hall.

Only five applications were returned to the City for the position of temporary general laborer. Of the five, three were city residents. After much discussion, a motion was made by Hepler to hire all three of these applicants, as there seems to be enough general maintenance to warrant this action. Seconded by Thompson. Carried. The temporary laborers will be Brian Armstrong, Eric Ehrenfried and Kevin Pitts.

It was decided that the four handicap parking signs would be placed at the alleys on the square make for easier access.

The Council instructed the employees to take July 3 off as the 4th falls on Saturday this year.

The police was postponed until the next meeting as it was felt the City attorney should be present.

Vicki Mensing, Russell and Lucille Raasch were present to voice questions about the intentions of the Council concerning the police.

Motion by Hepler to adjourn. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.
