The Council instructed the employees to take July 3 off as the 4th falls on Saturday this year.

The police was postponed until the next meeting as it was felt the City attorney should be present.

Vicki Mensing, Russell and Lucille Raasch were present to voice questions about the intentions of the Council concerning the police.

Two building permits were presented to the Council. 1. Chad Edwards for a garage 2. John Huddleson for a dog kennel. Motion by Armstrong to approve both permits. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

Motion by Armstrong to approve Hepler's Grocery's beer permit. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.

Motion by Thompson to approve all three cigarette permits: Casey's, Hepler's Grocery and Jo-Bob's. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried.

Motion by Thompson to approve Jo-Bob's liquor license. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried.

The Council discussed going County Protection and eliminating the City's Police Department. It was felt that they would like to have more input from the Fontanelle citizens before anything should be done. Motion by Armstrong to table the discussion of going County Protection until the next meeting. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried.

Henry Hyda asked the Council if they would have any objections to his widening his driveway. The cement would lap into the alley on the north of his house. Motion by Armstrong to allow this if Mr. Hyda understands that it will be at his expense if for some reason the town should have to dig at that area. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.

At 8:00 pm the Public Hearing and Letting for taking bids on the building to be built on the town lot was convened. Three bids were presented. After much discussion and comparison of the bids, a motion was made by Pitts to accept the Farmer's Lumber Co. bid. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried. The Public Hearing was then closed and the regular meeting was resumed.

Employee wages were discussed. Motion by Armstrong to give no raises this year. Seconded by Hepler. The motion was not carried.

Motion by Thompson to give all employees a 2% raise. Seconded by Pitts. The motion was not carried.

After much discussion, a motion was made by Tiedeman to give no raises this year. Seconded by Armstrong. The motion was carried with Thompson and Pitts voting NAY.

The departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer asked the Council if he could attend a SIMECA meeting on June 24 at Newton. Motion by Tiedeman to allow Delmer's attendance to this meeting. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

Delmer was instructed by the Council to get at least two estimates for overhauling the tractor.

An inlet was discussed for drainage of surface water for Bill Glassell's. Delmer is to make the decision.

The police reports were presented.

Lois informed the Council that the GSC requested some sort of sign informing drivers of the T intersection south of the Center. A sign is to be ordered and placed.

An audit agreement with Poock and Siebke was presented for the audit of city books. It was decided to sign the agreement.
