Motion by Hepler to approve refund on the unused portion of the Country Diner's beer permit. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried.

John Fox of Blacktop Service, proposed a bid on street work. The prices this year will be the same as last year. It was hoped that anyone wanting their drives done or a quote to have their drives done, would leave their name and address with the City Clerk before the crew comes to town. A notice is to be put into the paper along these lines in April. Motion by Hepler to have the Mayor sign this proposal with Blacktop Service. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.

Jane Mohror of the Good Samaritan Center asked the Council if the City employees pushing snow could turn their blades enough to not pile a large barrier of snow in front of the parking drive. A number of employees have gotten stuck trying to leave or enter the premises. The Council was agreeable to this.

Elvin Tannatt asked the Council to consider closing and selling the alley that runs east and west on the north side of his new house site. It is to be put on the agenda for next month.

The budget was studied and after due consideration a motion was made by Thompson to adopt the proposed budget and have the Clerk publish notice of a Public Hearing to be held at the regular meeting March 1, 1993, at 7:30 pm. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.

Janice Gruber, the Fontanelle representative of the Adair County Tourism Association, asked the Council about planting wildflowers along the road ditch by the lift station. It was decided that she would have to talk to the state for permission.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Lois showed the Council a proposal from Rabe Turf Care for work to the park. It was decided not to do anything this year.

It was also decided to have Dale Finck do the mowing again this year for the same amount as last year, \$1500.

Motion by Tiedeman to have Lois attend a budget workshop in Creston. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

Motion by Tiedeman to purchase a new hand held radio for the police department. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.

Delmer informed the Council that the blue pickup needs four new tires. Motion by Thompson to approve this purchase. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried.

There is also a class on water that Garry should attend at Avoca on the 10th of March. Also, for Garry to qualify for his sewer certification, he could do correspondence courses at home for approximately \$120. Motion by Thompson to have Garry attend the class in Avoca and also take the correspondence course. Seconded by Pitts. Carried.

Delmer also informed the Council of an S-1 contract being offered by Missouri Basin Municipal Power Agency to the City for the purchase of electricity. Much discussion ensued. Delmer is to have Bill Radio of MBMPA come to a meeting to discuss this contract and answer any question the Council might have.

The monthly police reports were presented.

Motion by Pitts to adjourn. Seconded by Thompson. Carried.
