Motion by Nelson to approve the only bill presented at this time. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously. This bill will be for 100 feet of fire hose and a Scott mask. It is to be paid when the merchandise has been delivered.

Assistant Chief Ehrenfried reported that from Dec. 10, 1992, through June 23, 1993, the department had answered 8 fire calls, 18 rescue calls, 5 meetings, 2 required classes and 1 storm watch. New tires for the ambulance were discussed. The nylon tires that are on the ambulance now ride extremely rough for patients. Motion by Armstrong to purchase six new radial tires and to sell the nylon ones for the most that can be gotten for them. Seconded by Jacobson. Carried unanimously.
