Motion by Armstrong to approve the Road Use Tax report for 92/93 and adopt a resolution stating such approval. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the resolution adopted as:

Two bids were received for the slide. After opening them and discussing recommendations made by our insurance carrier, a motion was made by Armstrong not to sell the slide. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

Larry Warrior asked the Council to consider closing and selling that portion of Wilson St. that runs east of 2nd St. and abuts the school property. The Council studied the maps and instructed the Clerk to post notice of a public hearing for the next regular meeting at 7:30 to close said street.

A used underground fault locator from the REC was looked at for the electric department. Motion by Armstrong to purchase the locator. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

The condition of the City streets was discussed. Owing to the rainy weather this spring, and the lateness of the summer, a motion was made by Pitts to not do any streets this year. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously.

At 7:30 pm the Mayor declared the public hearing to sell a partial alley convened. Motion by Armstrong to sell Mildred Zimmerline the partial alley running west from 2nd St. between Main St. and Scott St. with the stipulation that it be paid for by Sept. 7, 1993, or it will be sold to other adjoining land owners. Seconded by Hepler. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Pitts to have the City's attorney contact the attorney recommended by the insurance company, regarding the possible police suit. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer informed the council of a CIPCO/SIMECA meeting at Newton on the 4th. Permission was granted for Delmer and Garry to attend.

The attorney reported two citations were filed for non-compliance of abatement notices.

The monthly police reports were presented.

Motion by Hepler to adjourn. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.
