Motion by Armstrong to approve both building permits, if they conform to code. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously. The building permits were for Mike Welsch for a pole barn and for Valerie Warrior for a two-car garage.

Dew Cass and Viola Larson asked the council about the nuisance letters that were sent earlier and if more were going to be sent in the future. They felt there were some properties that needed to be looked at again.

At 7:30 pm Mayor Ehrenfried convened the public hearing to sell that portion of Wilson St. east of 2nd St. that abuts the school property to Larry Warrior. No other adjoining landowners expressed an interest. Motion by Thompson to sell this property to Larry Warrior. Seconded by Pitts. Carried unanimously. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Thompson, Armstrong, Tiedeman, Pitts and Hepler. NAY: None. Whereupon, the Mayor signed the quit claim deed to sell the property.

Harvey Wallace of the Fontanelle Greater Community Foundation explained the difficulty Dr. Segrera is having. He asked the Council to help with utilities or student loan payments.

Colleen Kellerher with Medical Consultants explained in further detail the Dr.'s financial situation and asked the Council to try and think of any way they could help or if there were any programs that might be of benefit.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer reported on progress with the tie line with Farmer's Electric. The engineer will check the material list November 5. The new line from the sub station is scheduled to be started the second week in November.

A meeting in Atlantic with Trees Forever is Saturday, November 13. Delmer asked to attend. The registration fee is \$10. Also, a meeting on first aid and CPR will be held in Atlantic on Friday, November 19. Delmer asked that Garry attend. Motion by Pitts to allow both meetings. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Iowa-DOT is sponsoring a program to plant trees on state right-of-way areas. They will reimburse the cost of trees and the cost of installation if the plan is accepted. Delmer is to fill out the forms and coordinate the project if DOT accepts the plan.

The pumps at the sewer lift station have been worked on. One is now operational. Delmer is to check into the cost and effectiveness of a new pump and report at the next meeting.

The police reports were presented.
