The Mayor informed the Council that the City had been high bid on the tax auction. The price of purchase was \$235 plus a recording fee of \$11. Chuck Cummins had given an estimate for demolishing the house and cave of no more than \$800. Motion by Armstrong to have Cummins remove the building and cave after we receive the quit claim deed and have the property insured. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

A discussion of raising the landfill charge was postponed until the next meeting to allow the Clerk to present accurate information regarding how many residential and commercial charges now ensue.

Christmas bonuses were discussed. Motion by Armstrong to give the employees a bonus fo \$150 which would include the city's share of IPERS, social security and medicare. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

John Fox of Blacktop Service discussed doing the streets next summer. He said they would stay on last years prices for seal coat with patch running app. \$59.10 and resurfacing materials running app. \$48.50.

Kyle Culver of Topkore, Inc. also discussed the streets with the Council. He feels he could do our seal coat work for less and would like a chance to bid the job.

The Council delayed any decision on street work until after the first of the year.

Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer reported receiving a letter of thanks from Maggie Dodson for rocking the road east of her house.

Delmer also gave an update on the new electric underground line and the emergency tie. Both are set but not operational as of yet. Completion of both will depend on weather and other conditions.

Two complaint forms and a letter of complaint were shown to the Council.

The police reports were presented.

The Fontanelle Fire and Rescue Management Committee met on D December 15, 1993 at City Hall with Mayor Ehrenfried calling the mee meeting to order. Committee members present were: Hepler, Armstrong, Nelson, Jacobson and Pitts. Absent: Frank.

Motion by Hepler to approve the agenda. Seconded by Nelson. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Jacobson to approve the minutes as read. Seconded by Pitts. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Armstrong to approve the finance report. Seconded by Hepler. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Armstrong to approve the only bill presented at this time. Seconded by Hepler. Carried unanimously. The bill was for the Fire Department to pay the firemen for fire calls and meetings. The amount was \$668. From June 23 through December 12, 1993, there had been five fire calls, seven meetings, 21 rescue calls and two controlled burns. 167 people answered fires and meetings.

Chief Stewart reported that the number of fire calls for the year was less but that rescue calls were about the same.

Paying mileage for EMT classes was discussed. Motion by Armstrong to pay Cindy Grantham mileage for EMT calses and to reimburse mileage to Kaye Bax and Mike Sickles for when they took the EMT classes. Seconded by Pitts. Carried unanimously.

The possibility of having power steering added to the fire truck was discussed. Jerry Pitts will look into it.

Chief Stewart also updated the Committee on the donations collected for pagers.

Motion by Armstrong to adjourn. Seocnded by Jacobson. Carried unanimously.
