Motion by Tiedeman to have Garry Miller named as the City's representative to SIMECA and Missouri Basin. Delmer Miller will be named as alternate representative to Missouri Basin. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously. Resolutions will be voted on at the next meeting stating this change in representative.

The City's tree ordinance was discussed. Some standards are to be added and a removal by owner if on parking added. A new ordinance will be voted on at the next regular meeting.

The applications for city worker were reviewed. It was decided to have Garry interview the applicants and then to have a special meeting for the Council to interview his three picks.

The departmental reports were given and correspondence read. Garry informed the Council that salt and sand will have to be ordered. Also, there is an old sander on the lot that Garry feels should be disposed of. The scoop on the dump truck is in bad shape but will probably last out the year. The Council felt Garry should check with the state for a new scoop.

Garry asked the Council about joining a local safety organisation entitled South West Iowa Safety and Support (SWISS). The IAMU provides training classes. There is also 12 hours of on site consultation. The cost is approximately \$1000 per year. The council feels this is a reasonable fee for the services provided. A resolution will be voted on at the next meeting for joining SWISS.

The removal of the tar tank was discussed. Motion by Armstrong to have Garry call Tim Six about a crane to lift it onto Yarrington's truck.

The police reports were presented. Mel also informed the Council that most officers in the state are converting over to a semi-automatic pistol. He will buy his own weapon but it takes 500 rounds to qualify. Motion by Thompson to have the City purchase the ammo for qualifying and use for duty. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.
