Motion by Pitts to approve Al Mensing's building permit for an entry porch if it conforms to code. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously.

Bob Emery, representing the Good Samaritan Center, spoke with the Council concerning the electric wires that run overhead across a portion of their building. He felt that removing these wires should be a priority. The Council informed him that electrical engineers were looking into the cost of having that done along with replacing a line in the south portion of town. They also asked about a grease trap at the GSC. One has not been installed yet and the sewer line is still getting clogged and backing up into the Dickerson's basement.

At 7:30 pm a public hearing was convened to sell a property to Jim and Valerie Warrior. No one attended the public hearing. Motion by Thompson to sell said property to the Warrior's. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously.

Removal of the house east of City Hall was discussed. Councilman Armstrong reported that Chuck Cummins hadn't gotten back to him yet.

Departmental reports were given and correspondence read.

Garry reported that he had checked on sidewalk forms. The are 70' long and come in 10' sections. The cost runs between \$285 and \$555. Motion by Thompson to get two sets of forms. Seconded by Goff. Carried unanimously.

DGR is working on electric specs and costs for the work in the south part of town and at the GSC. DGR feels that our maps on the electrical system need updating. Ron Dykstra will be at the February meeting with cost estimates and options.

Garry has checked with the state surplus on the cost of trucks, snoplows and sanders. A '79 or '80 dump truck with sander and snowplow will cost \$7600. Motion by Armstrong to have the city purchase another unit. Seconded by Pitts. Carried unanimously. Garry, Don and Jerry will select a truck when a selection is available.

Motion by Pitts to have Garry and Dale attend a water/wastewater class in Atlantic on Jan. 26 to earn CEU's toward their operator permits. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Armstrong to allow GTE its proposed route through Fontanelle for the fiber optic cable it will lay in the summer. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Mel presented his monthly police reports.

Councilman Goff had viewed the library interior. He agrees it should be painted, and suggests they put cork board above the shelves for hanging posters. The Council feels it should meet with the Library Board or its representatives. Motion by Thompson to adjourn. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.
