Motion by Thompson to approve the building permit for Curts Queck for a garage if it conforms to code. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously.

Fred Burcham has requested a drop inlet be installed in his ditch. Motion by Tiedeman to approve the request if he pays for material and labor. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

The Library Board would like to appoint Steve McDermott to finish Ralph Wollenhaupt's term. Motion by Thompson to approve this appointment. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Tiedeman to have Dale Finck do the mowing of the park again this year for \$1500.00. Seconded by Goff. Carried unanimously.

Only one bid was received on the City's dump truck. This bid was from Kevin Miller for \$257.00. Motion by Armstrong to accept this bid. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

GTE has submitted construction drawings and copies of an Iowa DOT Permit Application to be signed by the Mayor if acceptable. After reviewing the drawings, Clint Hight, the City's attorney, noticed that on the drawings it called for plowing through the seal coat and replacing it with gravel in two places. The letter attached states that all digging required will be restored to a condition the same as or better than the original. The Council requires the Clerk to check which of these will be done before they will sign. If the attached letter is correct, then the Mayor can go ahead and sign the permit copies and return them, but if they plan to replace the seal coat with gravel, the Council wants that changed. Motion by Armstrong to the above effect. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

The Methodist church wants a street light installed. After some discussion a motion was made by Armstrong to approve this request and to put it on the north side of the drive if that is agreeable with the Church board. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

A letter had been received from GSC stating that a grease trap had been installed.

Motion by Armstrong to hold a public hearing at 7:30 at the next regular meeting, June 5, to close 7th St. from Main to Scott and sell the property to Bill Glassell if he pays the cost of transfer. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

At 7:30 the public hearing was convened to hear objections to the sale of property to Brad Bax for a car wash. Delmer Miller questioned the amount of money the City has in the property versus the amount of the sale price. Motion by Armstrong to sell the property to Brad Bax for a car wash. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Thompson, Armstrong, Tiedeman, and Goff. NAY: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the property sold after the attorney draws up a deed.

The Mayor reminded the Council about a landfill meeting May 9 at the Greenfield high school auditorium at 7:30.

Departmental reports were given and correspondence read.

Garry informed the Council that they would be getting patch tomorrow.

He also asked approximately how much he could spend for a tractor and mower. Some suggestions were made concerning tractors for him to look at.

Mel presented his monthly reports.

Lois informed the Council about a letter that had been received concerning the water fountain that used to be in the park. She is to send a reply explaining its removal.

The Council thinks the used typewriter Lois is trying out is too large and expensive. She is to look for something else.

Clint informed the Council that he hadn't heard from the Cable Co. regarding the franchise.

Motion by Tiedeman to adjourn. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.
