The application for a liquor license for the Stagecoach was not approved at this time due to the application being incomplete.

Motion by Armstrong to approve Larry Warrior and Virgil Holck's building permits for garages if they conform to code. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously. Motion by Armstrong to approve Wayne Newell's building permit for a mobile home to be used as a residence only if it conforms to code. Seconded by Pitts. Carried unanimously.

The bank requested that the north side of the square be barricaded on August 27 for an appreciation day celebration. Motion by Thompson to approve the barricading of the street but that no tent shall be staked into the street. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

A request to close an alley was denied due to the alley being used by the public.

At 7:30 p.m. the Public Hearing convened to hear public input on the bid letting of materials for the electric project. No objections were made. Curt Dieren of DGR gave the Council a bid summary of the material bids. Proposal #1 for furnishing 15 KV power cable - lowest bid was from Graybar Electric for \$31,110.00. Proposal #2 for furnishing single-phase distribution transformers - lowest bid was from RESCO for \$8,430.00. Proposal #3 for furnishing fiberglass box pads - lowest bid was from WESCO for \$1729.92. Motion by Pitts to accept these lowest bids. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Curt also informed the Council that everything was ready to go out for bids on the construction for the electric project. The bids will be opened on Sept. 14 and a Public Hearing will be held at 7:30 p.m. on Sept. 18 for the bid summary to be presented to the council and the contract award made. The regular meeting will be postponed until Sept. 18 so a special meeting will not have to be held. Motion by Armstrong to go out for bids on the construction for the electric project. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

The employee insurance is being changed. IAMU is leaving Aetna and moving to Iowa Benefits. Coverage will remain the same and the cost may be reduced slightly. Motion by Armstrong to approve the employee insurance change to Iowa Benefits if the employees are satisfied with this change also. Seconded by Tiedeman. Carried unanimously.

An overhead electric distribution workshop will be held Sept. 11 thru Sept. 15 in Ames. Garry would like permission for Craig to be sent to this. Motion by Pitts to have Craig attend this schooling. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unaimously.

Garry presented the Council with an estimate to repair the building that was damaged. Much discussion followed concerning whether to repair the building by removing part of the building and erecting a steel addition or removing part of the building and erecting another building on the town lot. Estimates on both will be studied.

Maintenance on the water tower was discussed. It was decided to wait for a proposal from Maguire Tank, Inc. before any decision will be made.

Mel presented his monthly reports.

Motion by Armstrong to adjourn. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.
