RESOLUTION 95.6

RESOLUTION APPROVING FINANCIAL REPORT FOR MUNICIPAL STREET AND PARKING FOR THE CITY OF FONTANELLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1994/95.

A request for a handicap parking space was made by Becky Boes for in front of her beauty shop. After discussion, the Council granted the request.

At 7:30 Mayor Ehrenfried convened the public hearing for the bid letting of the contractor portion of an electrical project. Curt Dieren of DGR presented the council with the results of the bids. The low bidder was Nikkel & Associates, Inc. with a bid of \$126,830.33 and \$4,530.00 extra for the alternate bid of finishing the north portion of the project before Dec. 31, 1995. Motion by Pitts to accept the

alternate bid from Nikkel & Associates, Inc. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Departmental reports were given.

Garry showed the Council a contract and a service contract from Maguire Iron. The contract calls for cleaning, inspecting and disinfecting the water tower for \$1150 plus coating repair is extra. Also a tank drain valve to be installed at \$1970. The service contract is for six years and is to be cleaned and inspected every two years and will spot coat any worn areas. The Cost will be \$1530 every two years. Motion by Armstrong to accept both contracts with Maguire Iron. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Garry presented as estimate for a new building and also an estimate for installing a metal wall on the back of the City building. After much discussion, it was decided to fix the back of the City building with metal walls and to install an 18 foot door with opener. Also, to level the floor and pour new concrete up to where the floor is good. Garry is to get some estimates for this work.

Gary Queck requested that he be allowed to block off the west side of Scott St. between 3rd and 4th on October 7, 1995. The Council granted this request.

Lois presented a thank you from Brad Honl at the Good Samaritan Center for the street work done in front of them.

Mel requested new front tires on the police car. Request granted. He also presented his monthly report.

Motion by Armstrong. to adjourn. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.
