If the proposed school building passes, a lot of work will have to be done by the city, such as running sewer, water and electricity to the site.

The street sweeper was sold to J & A Salvage for \$130.

Departmental reports were given.

Garry asked the Council if the repairs could wait until spring on the water tower. since it is getting so late in the year. No objections were made.

Havens Construction will possibly start work on the back of the City Hall building in a week or so. The roof has been stabilized already.

The electric project should start as soon as this week.

The state snow plows should be selling in a couple of weeks.

Garry was informed that there was a tractor at Greenfield Equipment he could look into.

Lois showed the Council a letter from the Sesquicentennial Commission offering a Sesquicentennial Community Highway sign, post and installation for \$40 each. Motion by Tiedeman to order two signs, one for each side of town. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

The police reports were presented.  
The reduce speed and speed limit signs south of town on the black-top were discussed.
