Changing the Council wages cannot be done in November or December of an election year.

A trailer or truck was discussed for use in hauling recycling materials for the voluntary recycling program started by the Lutheran Church. No decision was made at this time. Henry Hyda is planning to run an ad to clear up some confusion on what can be recycled and how it should be wrapped.

Christmas bonuses were discussed. Motion by Goff to give the full time employees a bonus of a City gross of \$150. Seconded by Armstrong. Carried unanimously. Motion by Pitts to give Debbie Frank a bonus of a City gross of \$37. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Departmental reports were given.

Garry informed the Council that the REC will be selling a digger derrick truck soon. Garry is to look at the inspection reports of the City's digger derrick and get estimates for fixing it.

The electric project is waiting on transformers which will be arriving soon.

Hopefully, the State will have the used snowplows in this month.

Repairs on the City Hall building are at a stand still until the contractor receives the steel siding. The wall is framed in and the ceiling is stabilized.

Lois presented a letter from West Central I-80 Development Corp. They are asking for a \$2 per capita donation again this year. Motion by Armstrong to have Lois send a letter of intent stating that the City will donate \$1424 in its next fiscal year. Seconded by Goff. Carried unanimously

Albert presented a request for a donation from the Southwest Iowa Coalition. The Council rejected this request.

Mel presented his police reports.
