Motion by Cummins to increase the library tax asking by \$450. Seconded by Honl. This includes the necessary changes in the budget. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Honl to approve the proposed budget, after changing the library tax asking, and set the Public Hearing for the next regular meeting, on March 4, 1996, at 7:30 p.m. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Departmental reports were given.

Garry asked to attend a workshop on energy efficiency plan writing on Feb. 20 at a cost of \$30. Motion by Thompson to allow attendance. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.

A drug and alcohol testing program was presented. Motion by Cummins to adopt this program. Seconded by Honl. Carried unanimously.

A substance abuse policy will be sent to Clint for an opinion, and will be put on the agenda for next months meeting.

Information on four digger derrick trucks was presented. Garry was given permission to fly to Indiana to look at a white Ford truck. After checking this truck, a special meeting may be called to discuss this issue more.

Mel presented his monthly reports. CPR recertification classes will be held soon, and Mel will need to attend.

Hiring part time help was also discussed.

Motion by Cummins to adjourn. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.
