At 7:30 p.m. the Mayor declared the public hearing convened on the 96/97 budget estimate. The budget estimate was considered and no objections were received. Motion by Honl to approve the budget and file it with the County Auditor. Seconded by Johnson. Carried unanimously. Motion by Cummins to adopt a resolution entitled:

Seconded by Thompson. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Thompson, Johnson, Cummins and Honl. NAY: None. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as:

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1997

The City received a check for \$2000 from SIMECA to be used for economic development in our electric system. Motion by Cummins to give the check to the Greater Fontanelle Community Betterment Foundation. Seconded by Honl. Carried unanimously.

The purchase of the 'Y' from the DOT was discussed. The DOT requires \$3000 as a purchase price. The decision was tabled until negotiations were tried.

Fred Skellenger, the Adair County Sheriff, was present at this meeting to give any suggestions or voice any concerns that the Sheriff's department might have to insure a smooth working relationship with Fontanelle's police department. Sheriff Skellenger suggests that a part time officer be hired to fill-in for Melvin when he is off.

Melvin requested a scrambled radio for more contact with the Sheriff's department. He also informed the Council that the police car was nearing 100,000 miles. The monthly reports were presented.

Garry asked that he and Dale attend a water workshop held in April and costing \$50 each. Motion by Thompson to have Dale and Garry attend this workshop. Seconded by Johnson. Carried unanimously.

Chem-Trol had sent a proposal to spray the sub-station, pole yard, slab area, sewer lagoons, lift station and City Hall. The cost would be \$470.60. Motion by Cummins to agree to this proposal after receiving a certificate of insurance from Chem-Trol. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Garry is to get proposals for spraying the park for broadleaf and aeration.

The employee policy on drug and alcohol abuse was discussed. Clint had a copy of the County's policy. The Council will study this policy and will discuss it at the next meeting.

Digger derrick trucks were discussed. Garry had been to Indiana to look at the truck favored by the Council at the last meeting. It wasn't in as good shape as the picture lead you to believe. Other trucks were discussed. Councilman Cummins is going to check with a company in Colorado that is going out of business, to see if they have anything of interest.

Lois informed the Council that SIRHA asks to have a commissioner appointed by the Council to represent Fontanelle. Harvey wallace was suggested. Lois will check with him to see if he will accept the appointment.

Lois also asked to attend the spring IMFOA meeting held in Des Moines on April 18. The registration fee is \$56.00. Motion by Thompson to have Lois attend this meeting. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.

Quotes will be solicited for seal coat and asphalt prices for doing street work this year.

Motion by Thompson to adjourn. Seconded by Honl. Carried unanimously.
