After discussing the legal procedure, a motion was made by Goff to hold a special council meeting to appoint a replacement for Honl. The special meeting will be held at City Hall on June 24, 1996, at 7:00 p.m. Seconded by Johnson. Carried unanimously.

Mayor Jacobson arrived at 7:52 and took over chairing the meeting.

Street complaints were discussed. Garry is to look into the cost of dust control on West Benton and to have some cold patch put in potholes on 4th St. Place.

On next months agenda will be nuisance abatement notices.

After looking over the County's employee drug and alcohol abuse policy, a motion was made by Goff to adopt this policy as our own. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.

Ed Friot spoke with the Council about removing part of his sidewalk and planting some shrubs and trees. This will be looked into and put on the agenda for next month.

Wages were discussed. Motion by Thompson to raise Garry's wages to \$12.10 per hour, Dale's to \$10.85, Craig's to \$9.00, Mel's to \$9.00, Lois's to \$8.50 and Debbie's to \$6.00. Seconded by Goff. Carried unanimously.

Departmental reports were given and correspondence read.

Garry discussed the changes in CIPCO's rebate program. Motion by Cummins to continue like we have in the past. Seconded by Thompson. Carried unanimously.

Garry reported that he had been to Nebraska to view two digger derrick trucks, and reported on their condition. Motion by Thompson to purchase one of these trucks for \$20,000.00. Seconded by Goff. Carried unanimously. Garry is to find out whether we should sell or junk the old digger derrick and the small basket truck.

Mel presented his monthly reports. The Council discussed the purchase of a different police car and also scrambled radios.

Lois informed the Council that Turk Roofing was called to fix the Library roof, which has been leaking. The insurance company will be informed that this damage was possibly caused by wind.
