

The Fontanelle Fire and Rescue Management Committee met on August 29, 1996, at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro-tem Thompson calling the meeting to order. Committee members present were: Dukes, Herr, Welsch, Frank and Goff. Absent: Mayor Jacobson and Johnson.

Motion by Frank to approve the agenda. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Herr to approve the minutes. Seconded by Frank. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Welsch to approve the finance report. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

The only bill presented at this time was for the firemen. There were 17 fires, 6 meetings and 1 training session. The total paid to the firemen was \$1192.00. There was also 33 rescues. Motion by Goff to approve this bill for payment. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously. There will be a bill from Ed M. Feld Equipemnt for a syphon approved at the last meeting.

The Lions' Club addition to the fire station was discussed. Motion by Dukes to allow this addition and share in the cost of materials. Seconded by Frank. Carried unanimously.

Chief Faga reported that he feels a committee should be formed to look into the possibility of purchasing a different pumper truck, also check on grant monies or other available funds. After discussion a motion was made by Herr to form a committee comprised of 2 or 3 board members, 2 or 3 department members and 2 or 3 city or township citizens. This committee would look into fire truck and/or ambulance needs, and also financing needs. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously. Herr will organize this committee and speak to suggested department members and citizens about also being on it. Dukes will also be a member representing the board.

The Chief hasn't heard anything from the fire training school as yet.

Under public input, the owner and publishing editor of the Fontanelle Observer, Gary Pedersen, asked the Chief to confirmation from him or an authorized department member of fire causes and property owners in the future. Unless there are injuries or other considerations, Mr. Pedersen will be given available information.

Motion by Frank to adjourn. Seconded by Herr. Carried unanimously.
