Seconded by Holan. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Dukes, Holan, Jaschke and Glassell. NAY: None. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the resolution adopted as:

Tax abatement was discussed but tabled until the comprehensive plan was completed.

The building of the park restrooms was discussed. Jaschke and Dukes will review all gathered information and report at the next meeting.

The Council directed the Clerk to advertise for a cleaning person for the Library and also for part time office help at City Hall.

The street committee, consisting of Holan and Cummins, will join with Garry when weather permits to determine what street repairs are necessary and make recommendations at the next meeting.

The Fontanelle City Council met in special session on March 23, 1998, at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Jacobson calling the meeting to order. Council members present: Dukes, Cummins, Holan and Glassell. Absent: Jaschke.

Motion by Cummins to approve the agenda. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Andrew Merical of Hydro-Klean Services along with Greg Shawler of H.R. Green Co., presented a handout about sewer cleaning and evaluations to the Council. Questions were asked and Mr. Merical explained the process of camera inspection and the reporting of the inspection.

Motion by Cummins to offer the contract of cleaning and TV inspection to Hydro-Klean and the cost should be app. \$5000. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously. A notice will be put in the paper to alert citizens to the dates of cleaning.

Flow monitors were considered and quotes on two types were viewed. Motion by Glassell to buy a dual flow monitor from Sigma. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.

A fiber optic cable to the school was discussed. Garry is to have the attorney review the contracts for the next meeting.

The need to name an alternate for voting purposes was discussed.

Motion by Cummins to name Ramon Jacobson as alternate. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously. A resolution stating such will be voted on at the next regular meeting.

Motion by Cummins to renew our membership to Iowa Rural Water Association for a fee of \$150. Seconeed by Holan. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Dukes to have the \$2000 contribution from SIMECA to development in Fontanelle given to the Greater Fontanelle Community Betterment Foundation. Seconded by Holan. Carried unanimously.

Tabled for the next meeting was a decision on whether to grant West Central I-80 Dev. \$500 from the utilities for the next two years.

Motion by Cummins to send Garry and Craig to a class on electric linemen training at Corning. the fee is \$75 per person. Seconded by
