The street committee, consisting of Holan and Cummins, will join with Garry when weather permits to determine what street repairs are necessary and make recommendations at the next meeting.

Motion by Dukes to have the \$2000 contribution from SIMECA to development in Fontanelle given to the Greater Fontanelle Community Betterment Foundation. Seconded by Holan. Carried unanimously.

Tabled for the next meeting was a decision on whether to grant West Central I-80 Dev. \$500 from the utilities for the next two years.

Motion by Cummins to send Garry and Craig to a class on electric linemen training at Corning. the fee is \$75 per person. Seconded by

Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Purchase of a snow bucket for the new skid loader was discussed. Motion by Glassell to go ahead with the purchase. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.
