

At 7:30 p.m. a Public Hearing was held to hear objections to a proposed resolution to participate in programs of SICOG. Motion by Cummins to approve the resolution. Seconded by Glassell. Carried unanimously. Roll was called and the following voted AYE: Dukes, Glassell, Jaschke, Sickles and Cummins. NAY: None. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as:

A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS OF THE SOUTHERN IOWA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS.

A motion was made by Cummins to apply to the County for inclusion of both annexed areas as Enterprise zones. Seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

Mr. Bernard Gundel was present to ask about the City's policy on placing a ditch tube on the north side of his property. The owner will be required to pay for the tube and the City will furnish the owner with an estimate for putting in the tube.

A motion was made by Cummins to table the mowing decision until the special meeting on Feb. 21, 2000 at 7:00 p.m., giving time for an ad to be placed in the newspaper. Motion was seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Lillian Nichols and Linda Jensen representing the library, attended the meeting to ask for an additional \$750 from the City. This would make the total allotted to the library from the City \$5000. Motion by Cummins to grant these funds. Seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

There will be a special council meeting on Feb. 21, 2000 to receive and adopt the final proposed budget and order notice of hearing.

The safety committee will hold an interview with Austin O'Brian, in regards to his police application, on Feb. 17 at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Glassell to advertise for a full-time general laborer for the city. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Cummins to have the Mayor talk to the Enterprise Club about handling the upcoming Ragbrai events. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Departmental reports were given.

The Council was informed that residents were inquiring about a payment drop box. The clerk is to look into a door style drop box.

Craig informed the Council that SIMECA is asking that electronic transfers be made to Iowa Public Agency Investment Trust (IPAIT) as a holding company to transfer electric funds for the SIMECA bill. Motion was made by Glassell to agree to this and hold a public hearing to hear input on a resolution to this effect. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Jaschke to enter into a service agreement. for engineering services, with HR Green, regarding the wells. Seconded by Cummins. Carried unanimously.

Craig informed the Council that the health insurance company is asking the City to sign a adoption agreement. Clint Hight will look into this before any response is made.

Motion by Cummins to adjourn. Seconded by Glassell. Carried unanimously..

A gas contract with Crestland Co-op was discussed. It was decided not to enter into a contract for gas and/or diesel.

Paul Zietlow asked the Council if they had any ideas for alternative funding for infrastructure. He is going to talk to Bob Josten and also Tim Ostroski.

Motion by Glassell to adjourn. Seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Jaschke to pay the firemen's bill and when the fittings are received, to pay the Feld Equipment bill. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Fire Chief Denny Sickles reported that since the first of January the department had gone on a more than average number of calls. One house outside the City limits is to be burned if the department is awarded a permit from the State.

The time for the next meeting of the Fire and Rescue Management Committee was changed back to 7:00 p.m. to accommodate at least two of the members who would not be able to attend if the time was left as is.

Motion by Mensing to adjourn. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.
