The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7:00p.m. at Fontanelle City Hall with Mayor Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Dukes, Glassell, Jaschke, Sickles and Cummins. Absent: None.

Motion by Cummins to approve agenda. Seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

Carol Reis was not in attendance. The Council discussed her problem and then moved on to Tim Ostroski with SICOG who was next on the agenda.

Tim Ostroski with SICOG attended the meeting to present information on the housing rehabilitation program. Grant has been applied for. We should know in 90 days. If awarded SICOG will put in the paper and applications will be taken. Motion by Jaschke to sign application for tax abatement papers. Seconded by Glassell. Carried unanimously.

Tim suggested that we apply for a grant from EWAG for the new well project. They have \$500,000 in grant money that effects the quantity and quality of the water.

Jim Main and Chris Peyerson from H.R. Green updated the city on the swerer project. A complaint from a citizen has been turned over to the contractor and their lawyers. The contractor is planning to come back as soon as weather permits to finish work to the lift station. Contractor work schedule hours were also discussed regarding shut off times possibly 7 AM to 7PM to cut down on overtime. Jim will discuss it with the contractor.

8:00 P.M. Public meeting was held to hear objections to an ordinance on No Parking on 1st St in front of the school. Proposed ordinance was tabled until more information is received.

The guttering at the Community Center was brought up. There is concern that it was leaking & the water was freezing on the sidewalks making walking hazardous. Council members will check into it.

A tax lien was discussed. A motion was made by Jaschke not to take a reduction. Seconded by Glassell. Carried with Councilman Cummins voting nay.

A short discussion about the sewer and water rates and electric generation. Craig to do some figuring and bring it to the Council next month.

The Council discussed NewPath Communications having been bought out by Galaxy.
