The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7:00 P.M. at the Fontanelle City Hall with Mayor Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Dukes, Glassell, Jaschke, Sickles. Absent: Cummins.

Glassell made a motion to amend the agenda. Seconded by Jaschke. Additions made to the agenda were a reply from Bob Josten regarding Summerset Estates, a reply from Employers Mutual regarding a prior claim and employee issues.

Paul Zietlow brought a proposal to the Council regarding the Summerset Estates funding.

A Public Hearing will be held April 23, 2001 to declare excess funds for the tax increment financing project and to amend the adopted budget.

8:00 P.M. a Public Hearing was held to adopt the amended budget for 2001. Motion a Sickles and seconded by Dukes to approve. Roll Call vote was held will all ayes. Cummins absent.

Tim Ostroski discussed the Housing Rehab project. We applied for \$414,000.00 grant and received \$375,000.00. The paperwork should be ready to generate sometime in July 2001 and the actual work starting around the first of 2002. Glassell made a motion to make a line of credit through SICOG making SICOG a sub-recipient. Seconded by Jaschke. Motion carried.

Tim Ostroski reminded the Council of the Dept of Economic Development monitoring visit on April 12th at 9:00 a.m. to review the CDBG project. Tim also reported we could apply for available funds for the fire department to purchase equipment, continuing education, etc. We will tell Fire Chief Sickles to contact SICOG to make application.
