The Fontanelle City Council met in a special session at 7:00 P.M. at the Fontanelle City Hall with Mayor Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Dukes, Glassell, Jaschke, Sickles, and Cummins.

Jaschke made a motion to amend the agenda. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously. Tim Ostroski was removed from the agenda.

Motion by Glassell to adopt a resolution to amend the present budget and to declare \$86,839.82 in excess from the Electric fund to be transferred to the TIF account. Jaschke seconded. Roll call approval unanimous. Resolution #2000.23.

Cummins made a motion to have DOT put a No Parking sign on the North side of Hwy 92 from 2nd St to 3rd St. Jaschke seconded. Carried unanimously.

Applications for the part time cleaning position were discussed. Motion by Cummins to hire Chad Herr at \$6.56 per hour. Jaschke seconded. Carried unanimously.

Glassell made a motion to decline to donate to the Grow Iowa Foundation as the Council feels it is a county government responsibility. Jaschke seconded. Carried unanimously.

The Economic Department Payment (SIMECA) grant was discussed with Cummins making the motion to split it evenly between the Lions Club and the Emmanuel Lutheran Safe House. Dukes seconded. Carried unanimously.

The Council gave Craig a USDA grant application to complete.

Motion by Cummins to accept the resignation of Carol Barrett as City Clerk. Seconded by Sickles. Carried unanimously. Carol is to run an ad in the Fontanelle Observer and the Free Press regarding the taking of applications for the City Clerk position. The applications are to be submitted to City Hall by May 11, 2001 at 5:00 P.M.

Carol is also to run an ad in the Observer, Free Press, and Des Moines Register for a policeman.

Discussion was brought up about purchasing a desk from the Observer for \$25.00 to use as the billing clerk desk. Motion by Glassell to purchase desk. Cummins seconded. Carried unanimously.

The Council discussed the detour through town because of the sewer project on 1st Street. Craig is to check with the county engineer about putting an embargo on the truck traffic.

Motion by Glassell to adjourn at 9:15 P.M. Seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.
