

City of Fontanelle
July 9, 2001

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7:10 p.m. with Council Member Cummins calling the meeting to order in the absence of Mayor Homan. Council members present were: Dukes, Glassell, Jaschke and Sickles.

Motion by Jaschke to approve the agenda, seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Council reviewed a memo provided by Glassell, containing supportive data regarding insurance reimbursement to Carol Barrett. Motion was made by Dukes, seconded by Jaschke to have City Clerk reimburse \$19.63 to Barrett. Carried unanimously.

Part-time assistant city clerk position was discussed. Council reviewed a letter from Debra Dukes, present part-time assistant city clerk. Debra asked council to re-consider wage increase discussed at the June 11, 2001 regular meeting. Motion by Glassell, seconded by Jaschke to offer Debra \$8.50 per hour retroactive to June 11, 2001 meeting. Carried with Dukes abstaining. Discussion also held regarding replacement from received applications if Debra would not accept this offer. Rod Dukes said that he would speak with Debra and was asked to have Debra call Jaschke to report her decision.

Carpet cleaning bids for both community center and city hall were reviewed. Motion by Dukes, seconded by Sickles to award work to Curtis Cleaning Service of Creston. Carried unanimously.

Building permit of Randy Glassell reviewed. Craig reported that he had looked at site and project falls within ordinance guidelines. Glassell reported that they would be moving building three feet to south to allow access to water line. Motion by Dukes, seconded by Sickles to approve. Carried with Glassell abstaining.

Gary Paine property discussed. Paine had contacted city attorney regarding the possibility of deeding property over to city. No action taken.

Discussion of damage claim received from Mrs. Evelyn Baudler, for damages during sewer project. Copies of claim have been forwarded to H&R Green and and project engineer to be addressed.

Motion made by Dukes, seconded by Jaschke to have copies of Minimum Assessment Agreement for Zietlow Development, forwarded to Tim Ostraski for review. Carried unanimously.

Council reviewed No Parking ordinance for First Street. A public hearing will be held at the next regular council meeting on August 13, 2001, to amend the code of ordinances for the City of Fontanelle, Iowa 1992, by amending 69.08 subparagraph 2, amending no parking zones on First Street.

Motioned by Dukes, seconded by Sickles to approve minutes. Carried unanimously.

Motioned by Sickles, seconded by Glassell to approve the clerk's report. Carried unanimously. Motioned by Dukes, seconded by Jaschke to approve bills for payment. Carried unanimously.
