Department reports were given.

Jaschke made a motion to approve the clerk's report. Dukes seconded. Carried unanimously.

Susan presented bills for replacing the computer and printer at City Hall. After reviewing the bids, Jaschke made a motion to accept the bid from First Stop Computers for \$1425.00. Glassell seconded. Carried unanimously. Susan was given permission to switch long distance service from AT&T to Iowa Telecom. Janice Gruber has requested that the City donate an item for a time capsule to be buried by the Adair County Historical Society later this month. Paul Zietlow had a water leak at Summerset Estates and is requesting that half of his bill be forgiven. No action was taken at this time. Susan will check into filing small claims on money owed the city.

Police report was presented. Jaschke made a motion to purchase a winter coat for Keith, Dukes seconded. Carried unanimously. Keith presented a plan for repainting the Welcome to Fontanelle signs. Keith reported people parking along 1st Street in front of the school waiting to pick up children, which is in violation of the parking ordinance. Keith was directed to speak to Matt Ludwig, middle school principal, and request a note be sent home directing parents to park along the south side of the school if they wish to pick up their children. Keith requested a pay raise for reserve officers, Jake Matthews and Corey Larsen. Glassell made a motion to raise the reserve officers to \$11.25 per hour with hours worked to be at Chief Nath's discretion. Dukes seconded. Carried unanimously.

Craig Ford presented his report. He will be flushing hydrants if it continues to rain, and will also be ordering sand and salt for the winter. The street committee and Craig will work together on the Parkis Addition Street. Craig was directed to order a new set of tires for the skid loader.

Matt Tipling was present to discuss options to City health insurance. No action was taken at this time.

An ordinance to meet the Department of Natural Resources mandate for unit based pricing was discussed and changes were made. This ordinance will be published and a public hearing will be scheduled for the next council meeting.

West Central I80 funding request was discussed. Susan will check and see when and how much was paid last.

Jaschke made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 p.m. Sickles seconded. Carried unanimously.
