

City of Fontanelle
December 10, 2001

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7 p.m. with Mayor Scott Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Dukes, Jaschke, Glassell, Cummins, and Sickles. Absent: none.

Motion by Cummins to approve the agenda with the addition of a sewer complaint, seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

Matt Deluhery, Dave Dunfee, Dave Bauer, and David Jungmann were present to discuss possibility of SIRWA providing water for the city. Franchising the entire water system and buying water in bulk were discussed. Matt will figure costs more in depth and present them at the January 2002 council meeting.

Dave Bauer presented a pay estimate for H R Green for the sewer project. Cummins made a motion to pay estimate, Dukes seconded. Carried unanimously.

Property tax abatement for the new home in the Parkis Addition was discussed. \$23,419.00 of the assessed cost of the home cannot be abated due to work being done before the tax abatement ordinance was adopted. Homan will relay information to the Assessor's office.

Elinore Edwards's family has requested permission to brick around the planters in the city park. They would do either two or four planters depending on the cost. Permission was given.

Homan reported that a business owner has requested that the one-way restriction on the alley on the south side of the square be removed. Susan is to contact Clint Hight about changing the ordinance.

Cummins made a motion to send a letter of support to Southern Iowa Council of Governments regarding the grant application for an innovative regional housing rehabilitation program. Seconded by Jaschke seconded. Carried unanimously.

The Council reviewed priority list from SICOG.

Jaschke made a motion to give the full-time city employees a \$150.00 Christmas bonus, Dukes seconded. Carried unanimously.

Proposal from Banyon Data Systems was reviewed. Jaschke made a motion to change over the utility billing to Banyon Data Systems. Sickles seconded. Carried unanimously.

Jaschke made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 13, 2001 meeting, the clerk's report, and the list of bills to be paid. Sickles seconded. Carried unanimously.
