Motion by Jaschke to approve the agenda as presented, the minutes from the April 25, 2002 meeting, and the finance report. Seconded by Herr. Carried unanimously.

Fire Chief Sickles presented a bill from Holan Construction for concrete work at the fire station. Dukes made a motion to pay the bill. Jaschke seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

Sickles stated Tyson Sickles has started a EMT B class. He will present the bill for that when it arrives. He reported Clella Buckner and Carol Barrett will be leaving the fire department due to medical reasons, and Jack Zimmerline will be leaving when he moves to Greenfield. He also reported that the ambulance needs some work on the brakes.

The rate increase from Iowa Telecom was discussed. Susan checked prices with Iowa Telecom and with Local Link for providing phone and internet service. Mensing made a motion to have the extra phone line at the fire station removed and switch to wireless internet service through Local Link. Dukes seconded the motion. Carried unanimously. Dukes made a motion to approve a BB gun permit for David Homan. Baudler seconded, carried unanimously.

Problems with extra toilet paper and paper towels disappearing from the community center were discussed.

The Mayor reported complaints regarding unlicensed cars on city parking. Keith was directed to warn owners.

Departmental Reports

Keith reported that he has \$1060.00 donated so far to assist in paying for flashing red lights to be attached to the school stop signs.

Craig has a \$2000.00 estimate from Paul Bathurst to remove 4 trees with city employees helping remove debris. Craig is to get more estimates. The property owner has offered to help with the cost of removing the trees. Craig discussed the leaking gutter at the Community Center with Mike Warrior. Mike would prefer to leave the commercial guttering in place and try some special caulking he has before attempting to replace the gutter. Jaschke made a motion to have Mike Warrior caulk the Community Center guttering, Dukes seconded the motion. Carried unanimously. Craig has been looking at water fountains to put in the park as we have a donation from the Masonic Lodge. The council asked Keith to lock the park restrooms at night to prevent vandalism. The park shelter roofs are in need of repair. Shingles versus tin was discussed. Craig will get estimates of both methods and report back. The ditch at the coop needs cleaned out. We would need to rent a backhoe to do this properly. Craig is looking for a replacement dump truck. The skid loader needs painted before winter. Craig is to get estimates of replacing it or painting it.

Jim Mayne, Howard R. Green representative, discussed acceptance of the sewer project. Cummins moved to accept the sewer project. Motion seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

Cummins moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 p.m. Motion seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.
