

City of Fontanelle

July 8, 2002

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tem Cummins calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Jaschke, Baudler, Sickles. Absent: Dukes, Homan.

Motion by Jaschke to approve the agenda with the addition of water use restriction. Motion seconded by Baudler. Carried unanimously.

Baudler made a motion to approve building permits for Richard Williamson and Mike Sickles. Motion seconded by Sickles. Carried unanimously.

Motion by Baudler to approve Dennis Parkis for a BB Gun Permit. Sickles seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Gene Held, Fontanelle Lion's Club Representative, was present to discuss the proposed addition to the fire station. He had some estimates for a pole type addition. Gene will get some firmer estimates and bring them to the next council meeting.

Tim Larsen, from Southern Iowa Council of Governments presented bids for rehabilitating three homes in Fontanelle with grant funds. Jaschke made a motion to accept the low bid from Lutrick Construction for Project #1 in the amount of \$36,050.00, Project #2 for \$31,300.00, and Project #3 for \$23,850.00. Baudler seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

Baudler made a motion to accept Paul Nagel's bid of \$1,770.00 to remove asbestos from the Project #2 home. Jaschke second, motion carried unanimously.

Baudler moved to approve Draw Down #1 requesting funds from the state in the amount of \$4650.00. Jaschke seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

Mark Duben from Howard R. Green Company was present to discuss the progress on the emergency water line from Greenfield. The environmental assessment has been completed and submitted to Rural Development. He is hoping we will hear back yet this week on any archeological surveys that might need to be done, then we can proceed to posting notice and letting bids. He is estimating we will not be able to break ground on the project until this fall. Mark presented an engineering contract for the project. Howard R. Green has accrued costs of \$6000.00 so far and presented a contract for \$71,000.00 for total engineering services for the water line project. Sickles made a motion to approve the contract as presented. Jaschke seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

The sewer project was discussed. The city attorney needs some additional information before he can write a letter to H & W Contracting.

Motion by Jaschke to adopt a resolution setting the salaries and appointed officers and employees of the City of Fontanelle for the year 2002/2003 as follows:

Jaschke made a motion to re-appoint Mary Miller to the library board for a six-year term. Sickles seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

Baudler made a motion to approve the clerk's report, list of bills, and minutes from June meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Jaschke. Carried unanimously.

Departmental Reports

Keith reported that the flashing red lights for the school stop signs have arrived and will be installed before school begins. Junk cars were discussed.

Craig reported he needs to order two transformers to have on hand, and also needs to order some #2 wire. He had estimates for shingling two shelter house roofs at the city park, shingles versus tin. The decision was made to re-shingle the two north shelters with the city employees doing the work. If the sheeting is bad, the old shingles are to be removed. Otherwise we will put a second layer of shingles over the first layer. Midstates Ford has a used dump truck for sale. Craig is to check into the upcoming DOT auction before a decision is made.

The condition of the well was discussed. It was decided to put an ad in the paper requesting conservation of water and warning citizens that we might have to start using the deep well.
