

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7 p.m. with Mayor Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Baudler, Sickles, Cummins, Dukes. Absent: Jaschke.

Motion by Cummins to approve the agenda with the addition of a building permit, Martin Marckmann, Gene Held, and the old fire station/library. Motion seconded by Dukes. Carried unanimously.

Barbara Jean Funke from the Adair County Sanitary Landfill was present to discuss clean up day and various ways of improving the program for next year. Having a spring and fall clean up day, requiring the citizens to sort the items, and charging \$10.00 per appliance picked up were discussed. No decisions were made at this time.

Gene Held presented an open bid from Farmers Lumber on an addition to the fire station. The extra cost of enlarging the addition from 16 feet to 18 feet was discussed. Cummins made a motion to approve \$6000.00 towards the construction of a fire station addition as the city's contribution, with the larger addition being preferred. Baudler seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

Cummins made a motion to approve Casey's General Store's carryout license for renewal. Dukes seconded, carried unanimously.

Motion by Sickles to adopt a Resolution Approving the Financial Report for the Municipal Street and Parking for the City of Fontanelle for the year 2001/2002. Cummins seconded the motion. The following members voted AYE: Baudler, Sickles, Cummins, Dukes. The following members voted NAY: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as:

Cummins made a motion to approve the 28E Agreement proposed by the City of Corning. Baudler seconded, carried unanimously.

The Cultural Heritage Consultant's bid for \$6610.00 for the archaeological survey required for the water line route was reviewed. Dukes made a motion to approve the bid. Cummins seconded, carried unanimously.

A petition complaining that the proposed ice cream store on the square was becoming an eyesore was presented to the Mayor and Council. The Code of Ordinances of the City was reviewed and the petition was discussed.

Motion by Cummins to approve the clerk's report, the list of bills for payment and the minutes from the August 19, 2002 meeting as presented. Dukes seconded, carried unanimously.
