July 10, 2006

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7 p.m. with Mayor Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Glassell, Sickles, Newton, and Warrior. Absent: Reed. All motions are carried unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Motion by Newton to approve the agenda as presented. 2nd by Sickles.

Steve Jorgensen was present to discuss the nuisance letters he had received. Steve felt more people in the city should have also received letters, and the ordinance is inconsistently enforced.

Marilyn Jacobson has resigned her position on the library board as of June 30, 2006. Cynthia Sickles has agreed to fill this vacancy. Motion by Newton to appoint Cynthia Sickles to a six-year term on the library board. 2nd by Glassell. Voting Aye: Glassell, Warrior, Newton. Voting Nay: none. Abstaining due to conflict of interest: Sickles. Motion carried.

There will be a meeting on the replacement water line project to the Good Samaritan Center on July 17, 2006 at 2 p.m. at city hall. Scott Homan, Susan Newton, and Craig Ford will attend representing the city. Jeremy Rounds from SICOG and Jennifer Myers from the Good Samaritan Center will also be present.

Reviewed an email from the League of Iowa Cities regarding a new state law, which allows information concerning emergency preparedness and security procedures to be confidential under certain circumstances. To receive this confidentiality protection, cities need to adopt a formal policy identifying which records are deemed confidential. Susan will check into this policy more thoroughly before any action is taken.

Craig presented a street bid from Blacktop Service. This was the only company who responded to his request. After some discussion, motion by Glassell to accept the bid from Blacktop Service with the removal of \$2131 worth of work, for a total of \$16,594.10. 2nd by Sickles.


