City of Fontanelle December 14, 2009

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 7 p.m. with Mayor Homan calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Shafer, Warrior, Reed, Sickles, and Glassell. Absent: none. All motions are carried unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Motion by Reed to approve the agenda as presented with the addition of Adair County Mitigation Plan as requested by Glassell. 2nd by Shafer. Approved.

There were no building permits requested.

Justi Christensen and Mara Zimmerline were present. Jerry Zimmerline will not be released by his doctor to return to work for at least the next 6 months. The Mayor and the council stated their appreciation for the years of service Jerry has provided to the city and their regret at this news. Motion by Glassell to lay off Jerry Zimmerline when his benefits run out in 2 weeks due to his inability to return to work. 2nd by Sickles. Motion carried.

Discussed the letter received from the state attorney general's office regarding the sale of tobacco to a minor by a Casey's General Store employee. If the city does not seek civil damages, the state will proceed with this and keep the fine money. In the interest in keeping the fine money local, motion by Reed to set the date for hearing regarding this issue for 7 p.m. at the January council meeting. 2nd by Warrior. Approved.

Motion by Glassell to re-appoint Denny Sickles as Fontanelle representative to the Adair County Emergency Management Board with Jim Warrior as alternate. 2nd by Shafer. Voting Aye: Reed, Glassell, Sickles, and Shafer. Voting Nay: none. Abstaining due to conflict of interest: Warrior. Motion carried.

Discussed purchasing land to move the city burn pile. Two letters were sent to property owners indicating our interest in purchasing land. Neither property owner was interested.

Craig discussed with council a basket truck he was interested in purchasing. He was instructed to take a day and look at the truck to see if would meet our needs.

Craig submitted a bid for possibly purchasing a diesel fuel barrel. During the recent snowstorm we were unable to purchase diesel fuel at the local coop due to a malfunction. This complicated our snow removal efforts. Craig would like to purchase a fuel barrel to ensure this doesn't happen again. We could then contract for bulk purchase of diesel fuel. Motion by Glassell to purchase a diesel fuel barrel with a meter. 2nd by Reed. Approved.

Motion by Reed to approve the list of bills, clerk's report and minutes with a correction noted. 2nd by Glassell.

The state requirements at this time are Fire Fighter1 training must be taken, but certification by testing is not required. There will be more department members needing to take Fire Fighter 1 training next year. Sickles discussed replacing the deck guns on one of the trucks
