Sandy McPeak was present to answer questions regarding the Fontanelle Bar & Grill's request for an Outdoor Service Area liquor license amendment. They are requesting permission to close Main Street in front of the bar for a beer garden on Friday, July 11th. The beer garden will be removed on Saturday, July 12th. She provided a map of the proposed beer garden. Sandy stated that Officer Henry had spoken with her regarding some concerns he had of people walking out of the beer garden with alcohol. Sandy stated security would be monitoring each gate. The sidewalk on the north side of Main Street will remain open on each side of the Fontanelle Bar. The council suggested blocking off south end of alley for additional safety, which was agreeable to Sandy. Motion by Shafer to approval Fontanelle Bar and Grill's outdoor service application pending dram shop approval. 2nd by Reed. Approved.

Motion by Warrior to approve the Nodaway Valley Market for a cigarette permit, second by Sickles. Approved. Reviewed quotes obtained by Craig for curb replacement in front of the Post Office, and at Main Street between 2nd Street and 3rd Street. All Road Use Funds budgeted for street work have previously been allocated. This additional budget expense would have to be amended and allocated from Local Option Sales Taxes Revenues.
