Motion by Baldogo to accept the agenda as presented, 2nd by Warner. Approved. Public Input

Motion by Warner to post pone building permit from Jeff Hanscom to build a fence, 2nd by Dukes. Voting Aye: Davis, Dukes, Baldogo, and Warner. Voting Nay: Fritz. Approved.

Motion by Baldogo to deny building permit from Jeff Hanscom to place a prefab building, due to building is not 3 feet from property line as required by city ordinance, 2nd by Fritz. Approved.

After much discussion, the council would like to do more investigating on costs of retrofitting the Nodaway Valley Market, and the costs of updating the current City Hall. Motion by Baldogo to send issue to special committee 2nd by Dukes. Approved.

Police Department report prepared by Pat Henry was reviewed.

David reported the city replaced several light poles that needed replacing, all electric meters have been replaced to radio read meters. David reported the draining issue at 422 1st Street has been addressed, with the cleaning of drain lines.
