## City of Fontanelle July 13th, 2020

The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Center, with Mayor Sturdy-Martin calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Huddleson, Campbell, McDowall, Dukes and Zimmerline. All motions are carried unanimously, unless otherwise noted. City employees present: Bob Rubio, Matt Heinz, and Amanda Held. Also present: Steve Marsh with IAMU, Chris Baudler, Scott Homan, John Baudler, and Jeremy Rounds with SICOG.

Motion by Dukes to approve the agenda and consent agenda,  $2^{\rm nd}$  by Zimmerline. Approved.

Public Input: Steve Marsh with IAMU talked to the Council about rates and how he figures rates. Motion by Dukes to start the process in changing rates to a fix/flow rate, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Huddleson. Approved

Chris Baudler wanted to know how long it will take to make the sewer rate changes. Council let him know that it will be few months.

Committee Reports: None

Officer Matt Heinz presented the police report to the Council for July. Officer Heinz let the Council know that the County received a grant to put radios in full time police and fire trucks with in Adair Co. Fontanelle received one for the truck and has been put in. Heinz also let them know a lot of his equipment is out dated and need to start thinking about putting some money back to purchase, also that the trucks air is not working and will need to find someone to recharge the Freon.

Mr. Rubio gave the city maintenance report. Rubio stated that EP Pump has looked at the lift station and gave a quote for new pumps, and switch board for \$52095.09. Motion by Dukes to purchase pumps, 2<sup>nd</sup> by McDowall. Approved.

Bob Rubio presented to the Council the prices on redoing West Washington, prices range from 110,000.00 to \$97,000.00. Council would like to set so much a side to complete this 2-3 years down the road. Zimmerline will talk to 21 Century and see if this plan will work for them.

Jeremy with SICOG presented to the Council the environmental study for grant money that was awarded for housing. Jeremy hopes they will have a final list of homeowner to them at the August meeting, and have work start this fall.

Huddleson asked Mr. Rubio if Edwin Place will be getting paved this year. Rubio stated that it was in the plans to pave this year, but Black Top Service said they could not as the base needs to be changed and needs to be in place for at least 2 years for the asphalt to last.

Council would like Mr. Rubio to have the concrete at the park shelters and bathroom fixed before next year.

Motion by Dukes to approve Lori Miller to the Library Board, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Zimmerline. Approved.

Council is looking in to changing the fireworks ordinance, and would like some samples on how towns are letting citizens shoot them in side city limits.

Motion by Zimmerline to approve having a city wide cleanup day August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dukes. Approved.

Motion by Dukes that the rental of the community center is only for the center and to have a rental agreement singed when it is rented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by McDowall. Approved.

Motion by Zimmerline to approve both building permits (407 Jefferson & 202 4<sup>th</sup> Place) pending locates, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dukes. Approved

**Resolution No 2020.13 adopting budget amendment**, Zimmerline introduced the resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Dukes. Mayor Sturdy-Martin called roll call and the following council members voted Aye: Huddleson, Dukes, McDowall, Zimmerline, and Campbell. Voting Nay: None. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted.
