The Fontanelle City Council met in special session at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall, with Mayor Sturdy-Martin calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Huddleson, Campbell, Goetz, Dukes, and Zimmerline. All motions are carried unanimously, unless otherwise noted. City employees present: Amanda Held, Joey Miller, Matt Heinz, and City Attorney Mr. Hockenberry. Also present: Tyson Sickles, Jerry & Marlene Davis, and Calvin Edwards.

Motion by Campbell to approve Agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Zimmerline. Approved.

City Attorney Mr. Hockenberry stated the issue at hand: is the building at 423 Washington is or is not with in the property lines, the building permit is for a 20'X50' foot building. Mr. Edwards asked the Council to tell him where his building needs to be at. Motion by Zimmerline to hire a surveyor to find the property lines to make sure the building is not in City right-of-way. Goetz offered some snow fence for Mr. Edwards to place around the construction site during the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July. Council discussed the drainage issues at 423 Washington and will place it on July's Council meeting. Council would like to see about updating the building code and permit process.

Citizen Complaints: Jerry Davis voiced his complaints on the Mayor of her actions on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, and the issue of Officer Heinz, as he has never been at his house for 3 hours or more. Officer Heinz shared a complaint from a citizen about weeds and grass at several properties, the weed committee will take a look to see if notices need to be sent.
