Motion by Sickles to approve Agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dukes. Approved.

Mayor Sturdy-Martin closed public hearing at 6:01pm.

**Resolution No 2022.6 City Budget**, Sickles introduced the resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Dukes. Mayor Sturdy-Martin called roll call and the following council members voted Aye: Walker, Sickles, Dukes, and Campbell. Voting Nay: None. Absent McIntire. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted.

Motion by Walker to have water and finance committee get together to gather information on next options, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dukes.

Motion by Dukes to approve Reliability Plan, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sickles. Approved

Council discussed options on burn pile, Council would like to see what grinding would cost.

Motion by Dukes to adjourn at 7:23pm, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Walker. Approved.
