The Fontanelle City Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. at the City Hall, with Tyson Sickles calling the meeting to order. Council members present were: Davis, D. Dukes, and Zimmerline. All motions are carried unanimously, unless otherwise noted. City employees present: David Sickles, Shawn Tippling and Amanda Held. Also present: Justi Christensen, Kay Bax, Vicki Brown, Dianna Goetz, Molly Lamborn, Michael Roth, Jessie Lund, Jeff Vandewater, Terri Queck-Matzie and Hector Vela.

Motion by Zimmerline to approve the agenda as presented, 2nd by D. Dukes. Approved.

Michael Roth with HR Green updated the Council on the progress of the waste water treatment plant.

Recognition of Visitors: Vicki Brown asked to have trick or treat moved to different night due to Grow is on Wednesday; Council decided that they will leave it on Wednesday from 6:00pm to 9:00pm. Diana Goetz requested that the animal complaint be removed for her goats getting out; Council thought that since she took care of the issue that the complaint would stay.

Motion by Davis to approve the consent agenda, 2nd by Zimmerline. Approved.

Rod Dukes and Brody Warrior handed in there resignation. Motion by Davis to publish a notice to appoint council members, 2nd by D. Dukes. Approved.

Mayor Sickles presented the employment applications, the Council will review the applications and set up interviews in a week.

Terri Queck-Matzie gave a brief overview of the Adair County Tourism Council. Motion by Zimmerline to approve Curt Queck as Fontanelle's representative on the Tourism Council, 2nd by D. Dukes. Approved.

Sheriff Jeff Vandewater let the Council know that the 28E agreement for the County Sheriff support was ready and passed it around, but asked the Council to take care of their in house issue first.

Jessie Lund presented to the Council his idea of having campers placed on an empty lot he owns in town, and asked if this is something they would allow. Council asked many questions and didn't see a big problem with it but would like to see a more set plan on the sewer issue.

Departmental report was given by David Sickles. David told the Council that the electric line that had a few bad spots has been fix, and that the Coop's new line is almost completed. David also presented 3 bids for the removal of a split tree in the City Park; Council approved to have the lowest bid from S& T Tree and Stump Service to take care of it. David shared that the utility box on the '07 truck is rusted extremely bad and asked if a new one could be purchased; Council asked to have price for next month's meeting for the utility box.
