Motion by Dukes to approve agenda, 2nd by Zimmerline. Approved.

Seth and Mykin with ISG gave an update on the new well. The well is complete and next steps are final punch list and DNR review.

Hilary Boden and Nathan Hubenka asked questions on a bill for curb stop replacement and why they had to pay for it. Motion by Dukes to drop man hours and equipment charges but the parts will need to be paid for, 2nd by Campbell. Approved. Nathan Hubenka (tree contractor) will take care of the bill. Dukes requested that the ordinance be published in the paper to remind resident that they are responsible for any damages on the water line, from curb stop to the home.

Motion by Dukes to approve tree bid for 210 Benton to S&T Tree Service, 2nd by Zimmerline. Approved. Motion by Dukes to adjourn at 7:09pm, 2nd by Huddleson. Approved.
